NEW BUSINESS

Item # 1 Budget 2019 – Mayor Pro-Tem Dick Hoffman presented a spread sheet that contained 2018 Actual vs. 2018 Budget with a plus 5% total column and plus 10% total column giving the dollar amount that was an option if Council wanted to go with that total. Most line items were kept the same as 2018, with the exception of Sales Tax, Culvert, Impound other, Audit fee, Advertising, Election expense, Insurance-Prop/Auto, Postage, R&M Vehicles, ECC water, Trinity Valley Electric, Suddenlink increased by 5%, Banking charge debit/credit, Computer expense, Ins – TML/Work Comp, Legal Fees, Printing, Payroll Expense increased by 10%. After a short discussion, on Awnings, Parking Lot, Road Rebuild, expansion to City Hall these itemed were added to the budget. Council decided Karen will plug the numbers and see where the 2019 Budget stands.
