Mayor Pro-Tem Vincent Babb called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Mayor Pro-Tem Vincent Babb called roll. Council members Dutch Antonisse, Michael Juica, Cody Barnett and Andrea Miller were present and a quorum was established. Mayor Pro-Tem Vincent Babb reserved his right to make motions and vote.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Item #1** Extend Declaration of Local State of Disaster due to Public Health Emergency – Mayor Pro-Tem Vincent Babb stated we are needing to do one of the following to the Declaration of Local State of Disaster the City put into effect on 3/20/20 –

 - #4 Issue a Shelter in Place for the City.

Mayor Pro-Tem Vincent Babb made a motion to extend the Declaration of Local State of Disaster for the city until the Governor of the State of Texas terminates the state of disaster for the state of Texas, seconded by Michael Juica. Four for, Cody Barnett voted “No”.
