Ordinance No. /19-/

An ordinance amending Ordinance Number 109 by adding a new section the effect of which is to permit East Cedar Creek Fresh Water Supply District to proceed with the construction of certain sanitary sewer facilities within this city's jurisdiction without a permit from or inspection during construction by the City, and providing an effective date.

Whereas, the East Cedar Creek Fresh Water Supply District proposes to construct new sanitary sewer treatment and disposal facilities within the area over which this city has jurisdiction, and this council wishes to permit such construction to proceed without the necessity of:

- (i) of any additional city permits, or
- (ii) inspection of such facilities by the city during the period of construction, as would otherwise be required by the provisions of Ordinance 109, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYNE SPRINGS, TEXAS:

Section 1: Ordinance Number 109, heretofore adopted on the 21st day of July, 1998 is hereby amended by the addition of a new section to be known as Section 4a. which shall read as follows:

"Section 4a.: The provisions of this ordinance do not apply to East Cedar Creek Fresh Water Supply District with respect to the initial construction and operation of the sanitary sewer treatment and disposal facilities (new facilities) on the tract of land adjoining the East right- of way of State Highway 198 within the extra-territorial jurisdiction of this City."

Section 2: It is hereby officially found and determined that the holding of the meeting at which this ordinance was passed was open to the public, and public notice of the time, place, and purpose of the meeting was given in the time and manner required by V.T.C.A. Government Code, Chapter 551, as amended.

Section 3: This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its adoption and it is so ordained.
