An Ordinance by the City Council of the City of Payne Springs, Texas establishing a new speed limit on certain streets as they exist within the City of Payne Springs, Texas, (namely: County Road 2529; ~~Wisham Land Road, Frazier Lane and Double~~ ~~_____~~); providing a penalty of not to exceed \$500 for each violation of this ordinance; making certain findings in connection with the adoption of this ordinance; and providing for (i) the publication of the caption of this ordinance in the official newspaper of the City, and (ii) an effective date for this Ordinance.

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Payne Springs, Texas:

Section 1. In accordance with Section 12.01 and 12.02 of the Code of City ordinances of the City of Payne Springs, Texas, a maximum speed limit, within the corporate limits of the City, is hereby established for each the following streets:

Each violation of the provisions of this ordinance is punishable by a fine of not to exceed \$500.

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that:

A. A traffic investigation has been made to determine whether a speed of more than 30 miles per hour heretofore established is a reasonable, prudent and safe speed under the conditions that exist on such streets; and

B The speeds set forth for each of the streets specified in Section 1 were and are reasonable, prudent and safe speeds under the conditions that presently exist on the respective streets to which such speeds greater than 30 miles per hour are permitted.

Section 3: This ordinance shall be in force and effect, effective on the 15th day following the later of (i) the publication of the caption of this ordinance in the official newspaper of the city (as established for the calendar year) in which such publication of notice is made; and (ii) the erection of signs designating the new speed limit for such streets near each intersection with another street. A certificate as to the date of such publication and the completion of the erection of the new speed limit signs shall be executed by the Mayor Pro-Tem, filed with the City Secretary, and such certificate shall be conclusive evidence of the effective date of this ordinance.
