CITY OF PAYNE SPRINGS ORDINANCE No. 18

- (A) It shall be unlawful for any person to discharge any gun, pistol, rifle, or firearm of any kind within the city limits, except within a properly secured indoor firearms range, constructed and maintained in accordance with the National Rifle Association specifications and standards or upon a range owned and operated by a governmental entity.
- (B) The terms "gun," "pistol," "rifle," and "firearm" as used in this ordinance shall only be defined as to include all percussion weapons.
- (C) This section shall not be construed to prohibit any officer of the law from discharging a firearm in the performance of his official duty, nor to prohibit any citizen from discharging a firearm when lawfully defending person or property.
- (D) Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a Class C misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished in accordance with the applicable statutes of the State of Texas.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYNE SPRINGS, TEXAS:

That the heretofore described ordinance is hereby PASSED.
