

ORDINANCE 2013-10-15

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PAYNE SPRINGS, TEXAS DIS-ANNEXING CERTAIN SPARSELY POPULATED AREAS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS.

WHEREAS, dis-annexation is considered necessary due to the lack of funds to properly maintain certain rural roads. Discontinuance of certain areas as part of the city will include only sparsely populated areas. (Ref. 43.144 Tex. Local Gov. Code)

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYNE SPRINGS, TEXAS. THAT THE FOLLOWING AREAS. DEFINED BY SURVEYOR FIELD NOTES. BE DIS-ANNEXED FROM THE CITY OF PAYNE SPRINGS. TEXAS.

WHEREAS. areas to be dis-annexed are described from current city maps prepared by Gearld A. Carter. Registered Land Surveyor no. 1935.

1. All of road no. CR2507 from road no. CR2529 to road no. CR2930.
2. All of road no. CR2930 from state highway no. 316 north to the present city limit.
3. All of road no. CR2501 and no. CR2502 from state highway no. 316 to the north city limit.
