 ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORYNO. $\qquad$
AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING THE HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED
TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF PAYNE SPRINGS, HENDERSON COUNTY, TEXAS, AND EXTENDING THE BOUNDARY LIMITS OF SAID CITY SO AS TO INCLUDE SAID HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED PROPERTY WITHIN SAID CITY LIMITS, AND GRANTING TO ALL THE INHABITANTS OF SAID PROPERTY ALL THE RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES OF OTHER CITIZENS AND BINDING SAID INHABITANTS BY ALL OF THE ACTS, ORDINANCES, RESOLUTIONS, AND REGULATIONS OF SAID CITY.

WHEREAS, Section 43.028 of the Texas Local Government Code authorizes the annexation of territory, subject to the laws of this state.

WHEREAS, the procedures described by the Texas Local Government Code and the laws of this state have been duly followed with respect to the following described territory, to wit:

Hwy. 90, Lot No. 125 B-C, Southwood Shores, Section 1 according to the Plat recorded in Cabinet A Slide 163 of the Plat records of Henderson County, Texas

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYNE SPRINGS, TEXAS:

That the heretofore described property is hereby annexed to the City of Payne Springs, Henderson County, Texas, and that the boundary limits of the City of Payne Springs be and the same are hereby extended to include the above described territory within the city limits of the City of Payne Springs, and the same shall hereafter be included within the territorial limits of said city, and the inhabitants thereof shall hereafter be entitled to all the rights and privileges of other citizens of the city of Payne Springs and they shall be bound by the acts, ordinances, resolutions, and regulations of said city.

The City Secretary is hereby directed to file with the County Clerk of Henderson County, Texas, a certified copy of this ordinance.
