ORDINANCE NO. 22

ORDINANCE TO REPEAL PRIOR DATED ORDINANCE(S) PERTAINING TO THE DISCHARGE OF ANY KIND OF FIREARM WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF PAYNE SPRINGS, TEXAS

WHEREAS, the City of Payne Springs, Texas (City) is a type A General Law municipality under the laws of the State of Texas, and

WHEREAS, former City Council(s) enacted Ordinance(s) pertaining to the discharge of firearms within the city limits of Payne Spring, Texas against the wishes of the citizens of Payne Springs, and

WHEREAS, the current City Council believes this is an unnecessary restriction on the citizens of Payne Springs, Ordinance No. 18 is hereby repealed.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYNE SPRINGS, TEXAS.

Section 1. The right to discharge a firearm within the city limits of Payne Springs, Texas shall not be encumbered so long as it is not done in a unlawful manner and does not create a clear and present danger to another person or their property.

Section 2. The provisions of this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage.
