

ORDINANCE NO. 25

**ORDINANCE TO REPEAL PRIOR DATED ORDINANCE(S)
PERTAINING TO THE SPEED LIMITS ON STREETS IN THE
CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF PAYNE SPRINGS, TEXAS**

WHEREAS, the City of Payne Springs, Texas (City) is a type A General Law municipality under the laws of the State of Texas, and

WHEREAS, former City Council(s) enacted Ordinance(s) setting the speed limits on city streets in the city limits of Payne Spring, Texas

WHEREAS, the current City Council believes it should be left to majority vote of the City Council to set or adjust speed limits up or down on individual streets from time to time to protect the safety of citizens and to facilitate the flow of traffic, all previously dated ordinances pertaining to speed limits within the city limits of Payne Springs, Texas are hereby repealed.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PAYNE SPRINGS, TEXAS.

Section 1. The City Council, by majority vote shall have the right to raise or lower speed limits on all city streets within the city limits of Payne Springs, Texas

Section 2. Any changes in the posted speed limits shall become effective when and only when the new speed limit signs are installed.

Section 3. The provisions of this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
